



Introduction to Heavenward

This MX-Linux distribution of **Heavenward** is dedicated to anyone who wants to grow spiritually. Heavenward should be installed to your hard-drive or external hard-drive, but can function from a Flash Drive at a reduced speed. I recommend a Sandisk 3.2.1 flash drive with 128 Gb. of storage space. Please make sure that before you install to the Flash drive, you delete all its contents and then format it, in order to avoid any complications that could arise from a hidden partition on the Flash drive.

Please note:

the password for the Heavenward distribution is Heavenward (for both user and root privileges).

For local Bible Study

The Bible program “Bolls” is included. This program has a choice of several Bibles and Commentaries and is quite useful for normal study. If you wish to add more extensive Bible Study Programs, I recommend BibleTime from the MX-Linux

repositories and “theWord” (which is a MS. Windows program, which can be easily ran on “Heavenward” using the wine application).

The desktop

The screen will change every few minutes to a new astronomical image or the “Heavenward” picture. This is done to encourage reflection of heavenly matters.
